## RESURFACING ACTIVITIES BEGIN FALL 2022

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to begin work to resurface U.S. 231 (Harrison Avenue) from U.S. 98B (6th Street) to U.S. 98 (15th Street) in Bay County.

## PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements along the 1.123-mile project include:

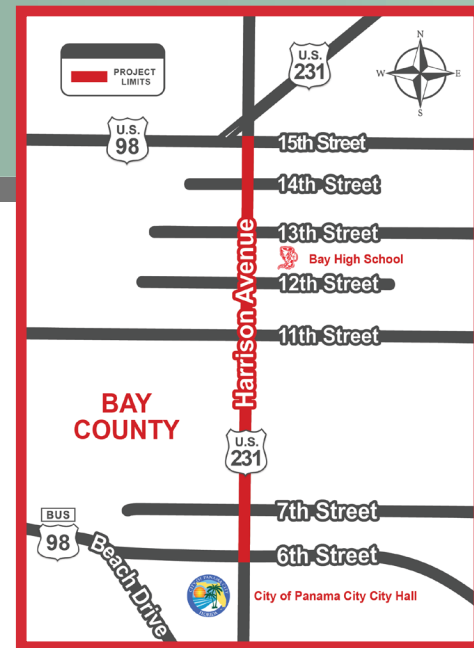
- Resurfacing existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, on street parking, and paved shoulders
- Upgrading sidewalks and pedestrian features to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Improving drainage at 14th Street
- Adding new pedestrian signals at 11th Street and 12th Street

## RESURFACING CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC IMPACTS

No lane closures will occur at the following times:

- 6 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday during active school sessions
- 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Friday through Sunday between Memorial Day and Labor Day

Work is scheduled to be completed fall 2023. Construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling through a work zone and to watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.

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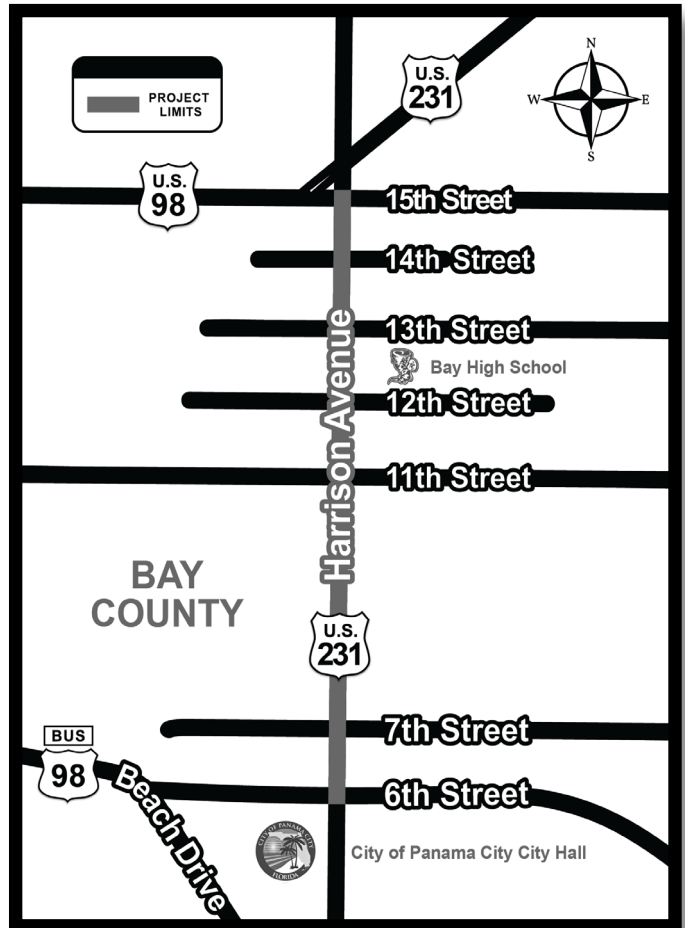

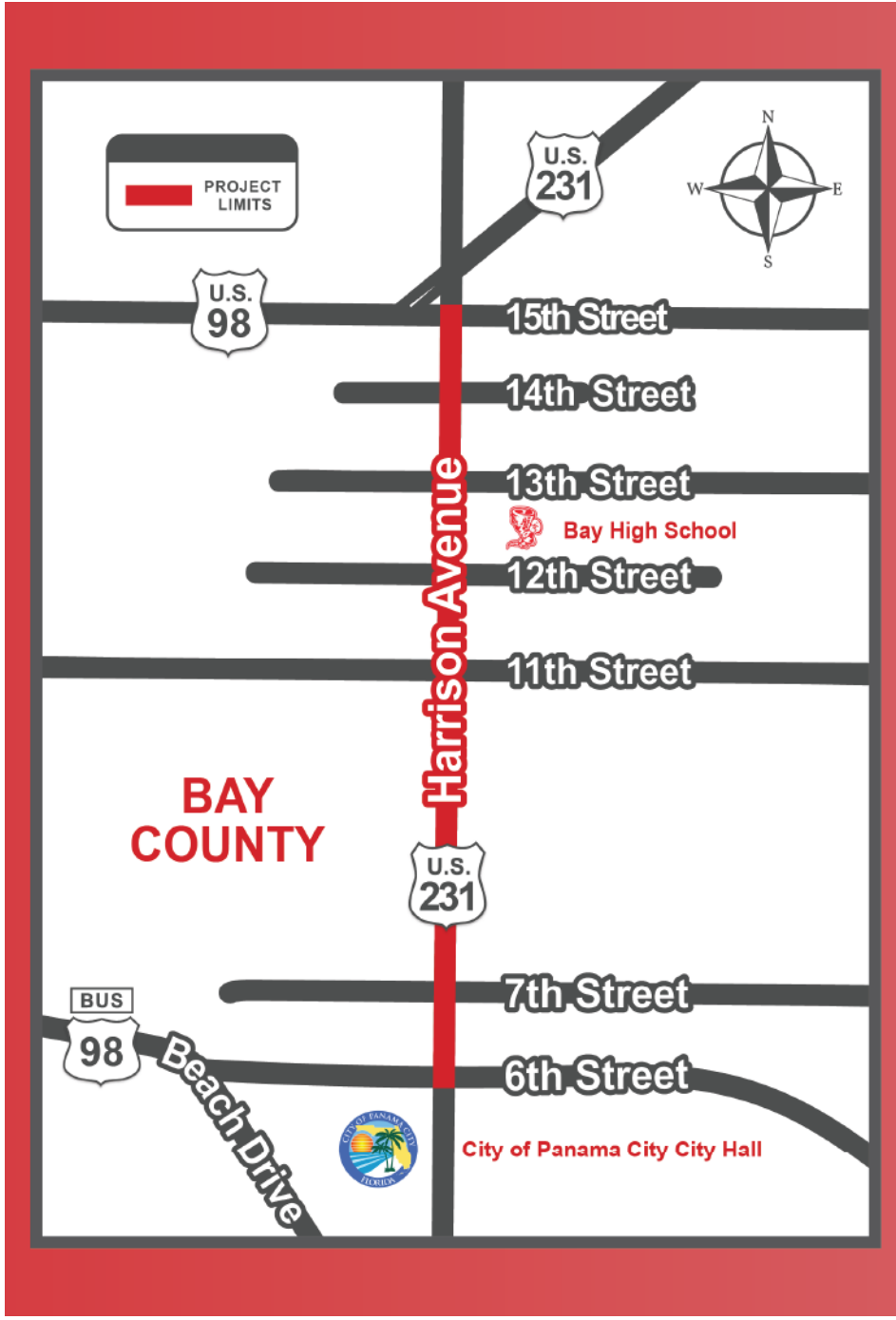


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
