

# RESURFACING BEGINS

RESURFACING ACTIVITIES BEGIN DECEMBER 2021

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin work on **December 4** to resurface U.S. 98B (Beach Drive) from U.S. 98 (15th Street) to west of U.S. 231 (Harrison Avenue) in Bay County.

## PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements along the three-mile project include:

- Resurfacing existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, and on street parking
- Resurfacing Johnson Bayou bridge
- Adding pedestrian lighting at the East Caroline Boulevard pedestrian crossing
- Drainage improvements
- Upgrading sidewalks to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act standards

### BECK AVENUE



- Beck Avenue from U.S. 98 to 10th Street features:
- 10 to 24-foot travel lanes
  - 10-foot center turn lane
  - 8-foot on-street parking
  - 5 to 8-foot concrete sidewalk on both sides

### BEACH DRIVE



10th Street, Chestnut Avenue, 9th Street, Frankford Avenue, and Beach Drive from 10th Street/Beck Avenue to 6th Street features:

- 13.5-foot travel lanes
- 5-foot concrete sidewalk on both sides for 10th Street, Chestnut Avenue, 9th Street, Frankford Avenue, and Beach Drive
- 5 to 6-foot concrete sidewalk on north side of Beach Drive

### 6TH STREET



6th Street from Beach Drive to west of U.S. 231 (Harrison Avenue) features:

- 12-foot travel lanes
- 13-foot center left turn lane
- 5 to 8-foot concrete sidewalk on both sides of the roadway

### FRANKFORD AVENUE



Southbound right turn lane on Frankford Avenue onto West Beach Drive features:

- 13.5-foot travel lanes
- 10-foot right turn lane
- 5-foot concrete sidewalk on both sides of the roadway

## RESURFACING CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Lane closures are prohibited Monday through Friday at the following times and locations:

- Beck Avenue from 7:30 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- 6th Street from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- 9th Street, Frankford Avenue, Beach Drive, and Chestnut Avenue from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

There will be no weekend work allowed in residential areas. Improvements are scheduled to be completed summer 2022.

Work is scheduled to be completed summer 2022. Construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to use caution and to watch for heavy equipment and construction workers entering and exiting the roadway.

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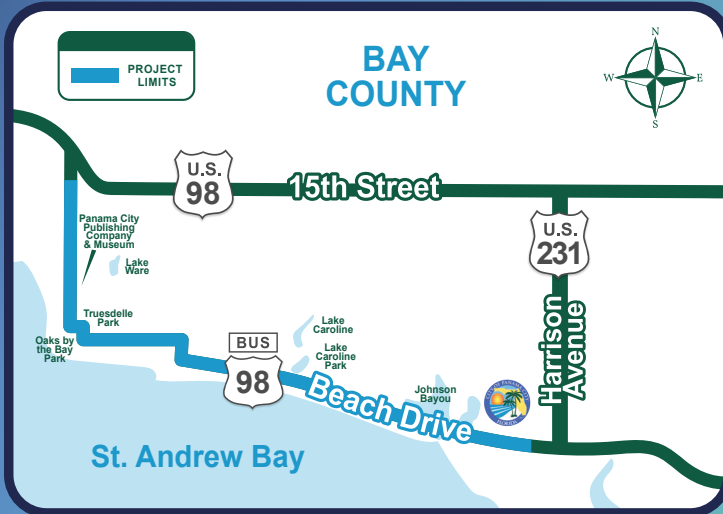
