

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin construction on a new two-lane roadway to be named State Road 370 (Gulf Coast Parkway). The development of the new road will take place south of Tram Road from U.S. 98 (Tyndall Parkway) to C.R. 2315 (Star Avenue) in Bay County.






