








U.S. 231 Bridge over Mill Bayou Typical Section

Sidewalk on both sides











- Providing lighting for the crosswalks at all three signalized intersections and at the mid-block crossing at 13th Street

PROJECT INFORMATION:

The intent of this project is to resurface existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, on street parking, and paved shoulders. Right-of-way acquisition at 14th Street will be required for drainage improvement work.
