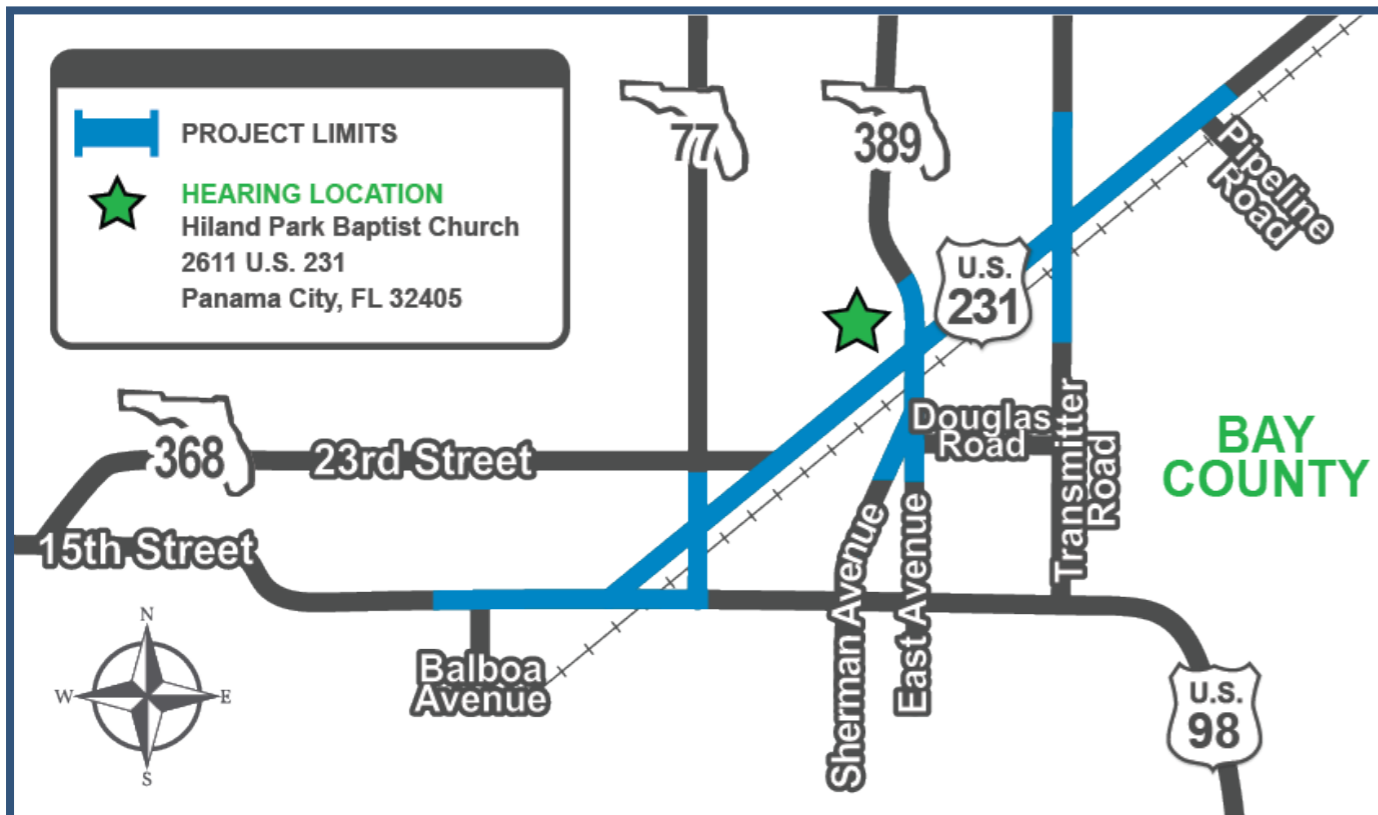

Both segments are funded for right-of-way acquisition. Construction is not funded in the current FDOT Five-Year Work Program.

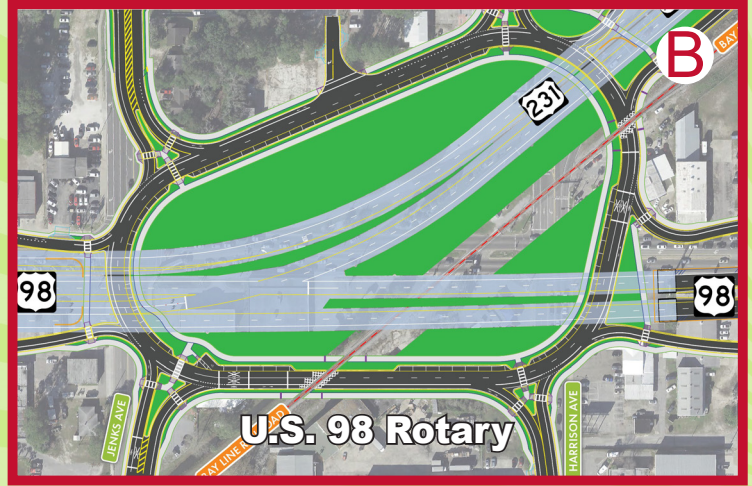

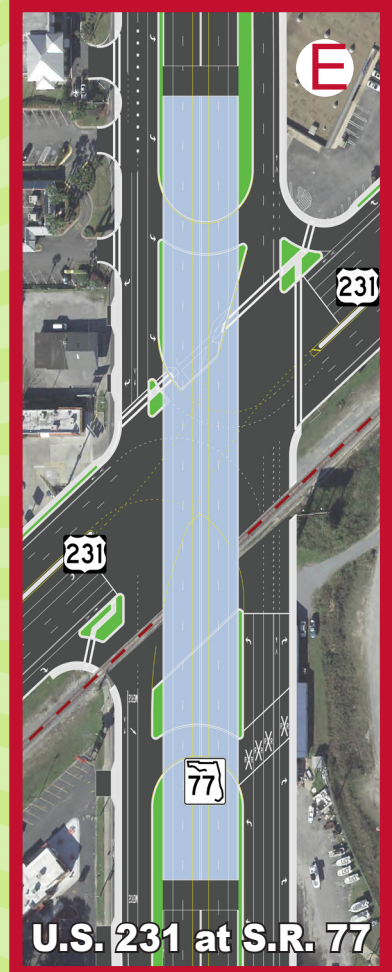

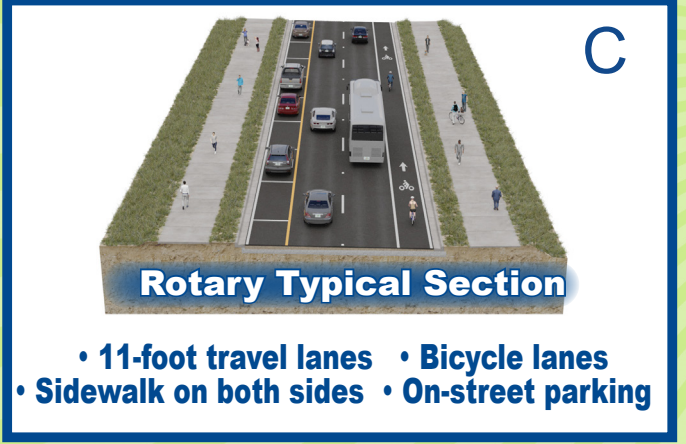

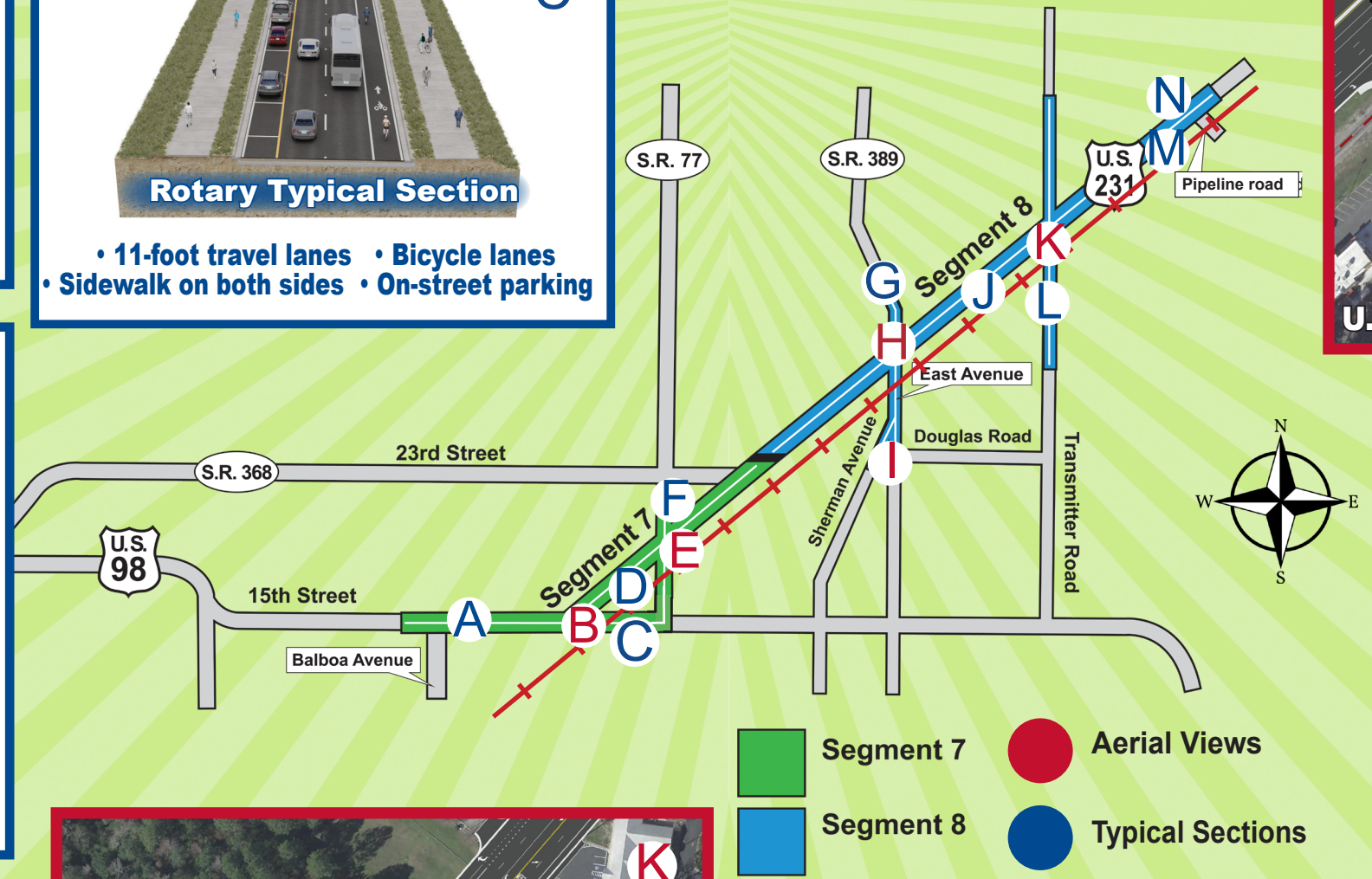

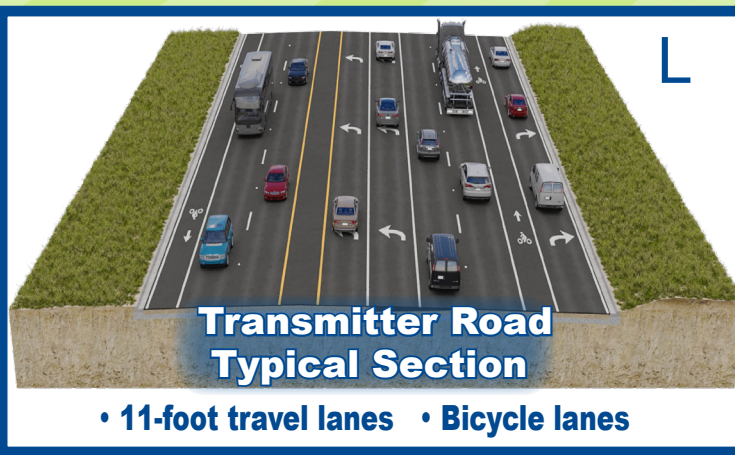

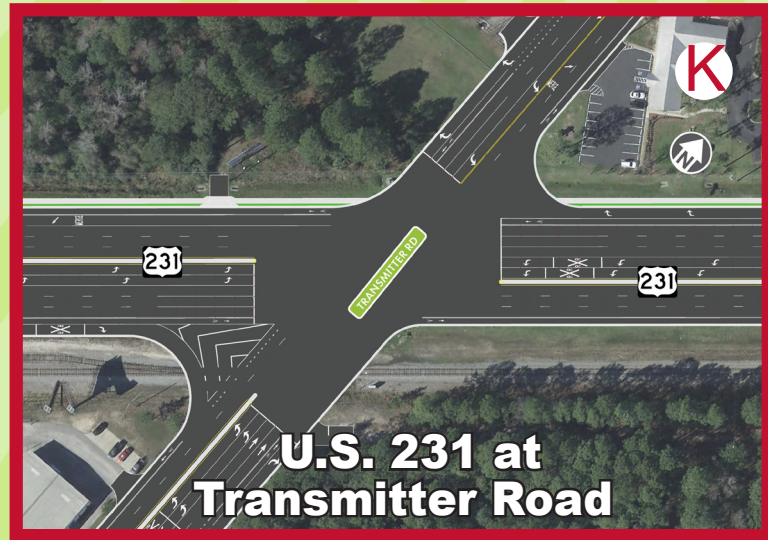

- ◆ Providing lighting for the crosswalks at all three signalized intersections and at the mid-block crossing at 13th Street
