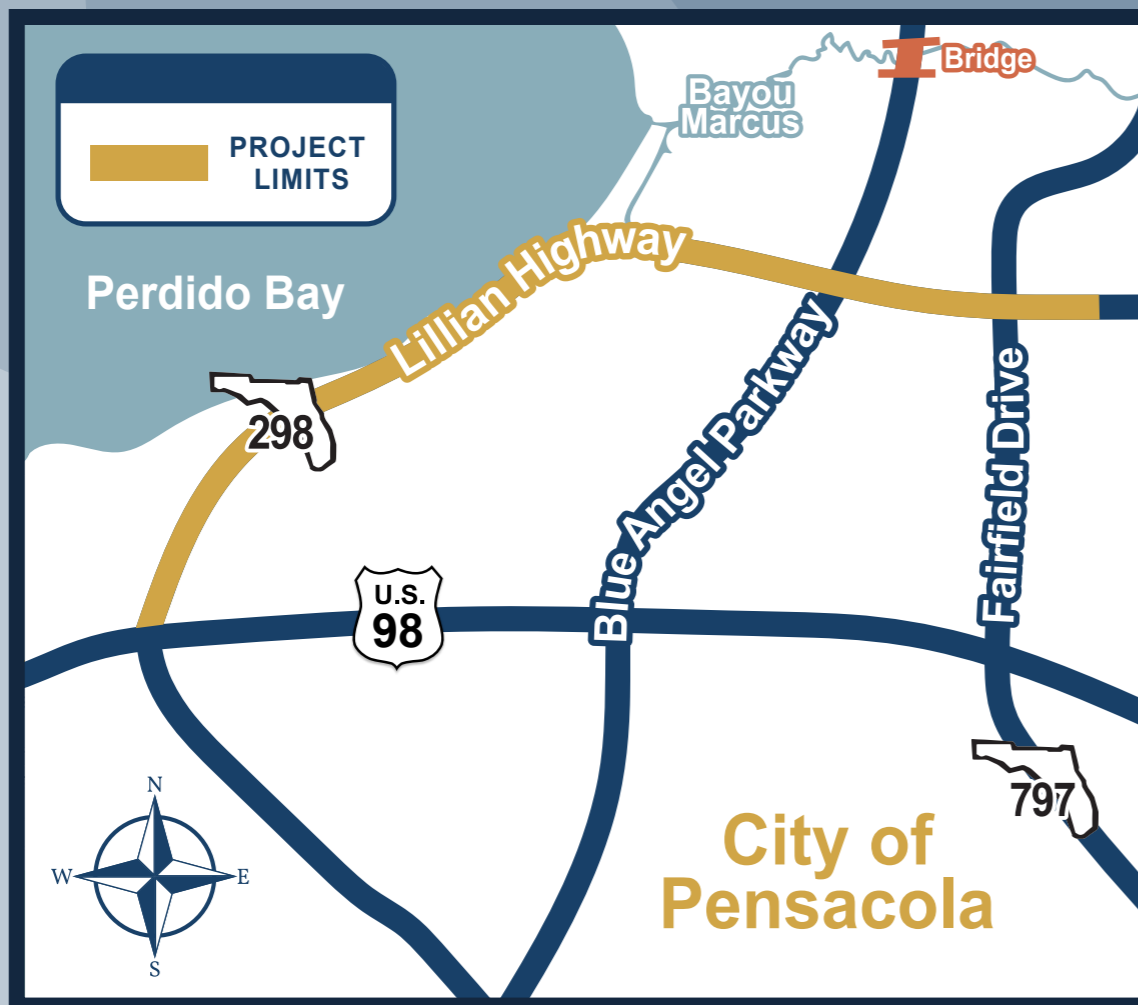

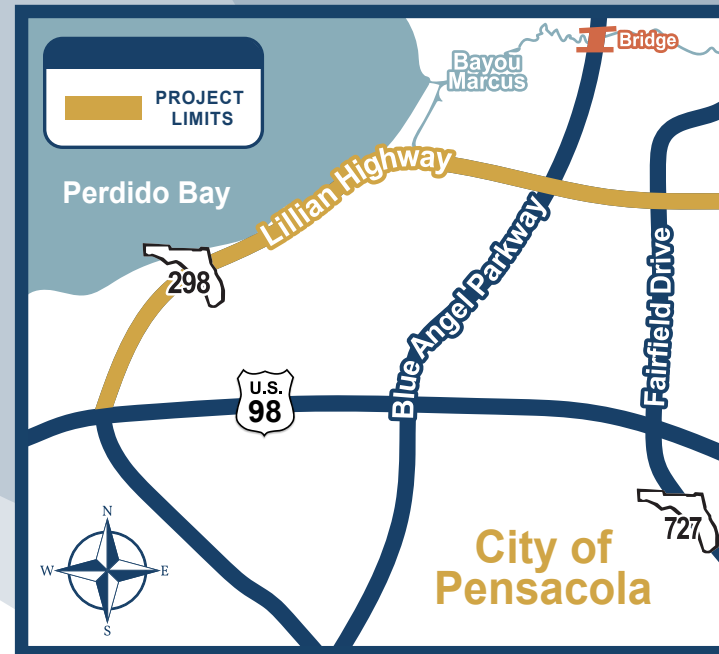

Project Information

The intent of this project is to resurface existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, and construct four-foot paved shoulders in each direction.

Additional improvements include:

1. New mast arms at Blue Angel Parkway intersection
2. Southbound, right turn lane extension at Blue Angel Parkway
3. Signal improvements at Fairfield Drive
4. Drainage improvements

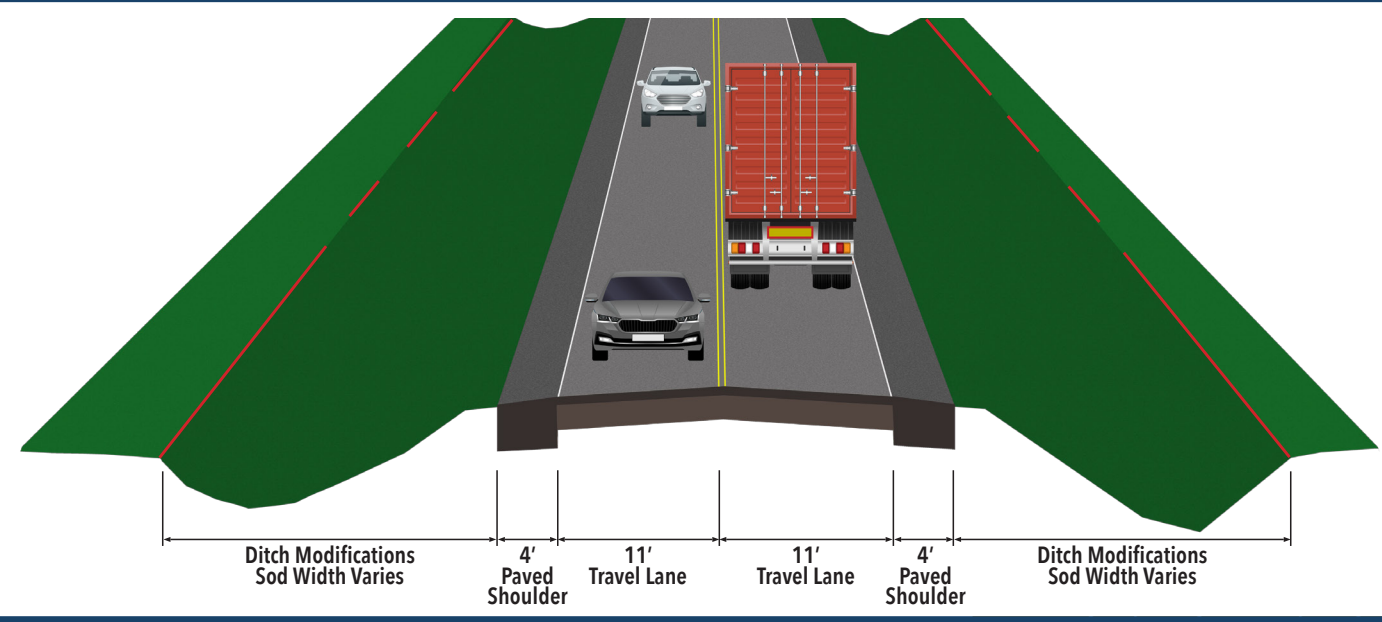


Existing Blue Angel Parkway Intersection



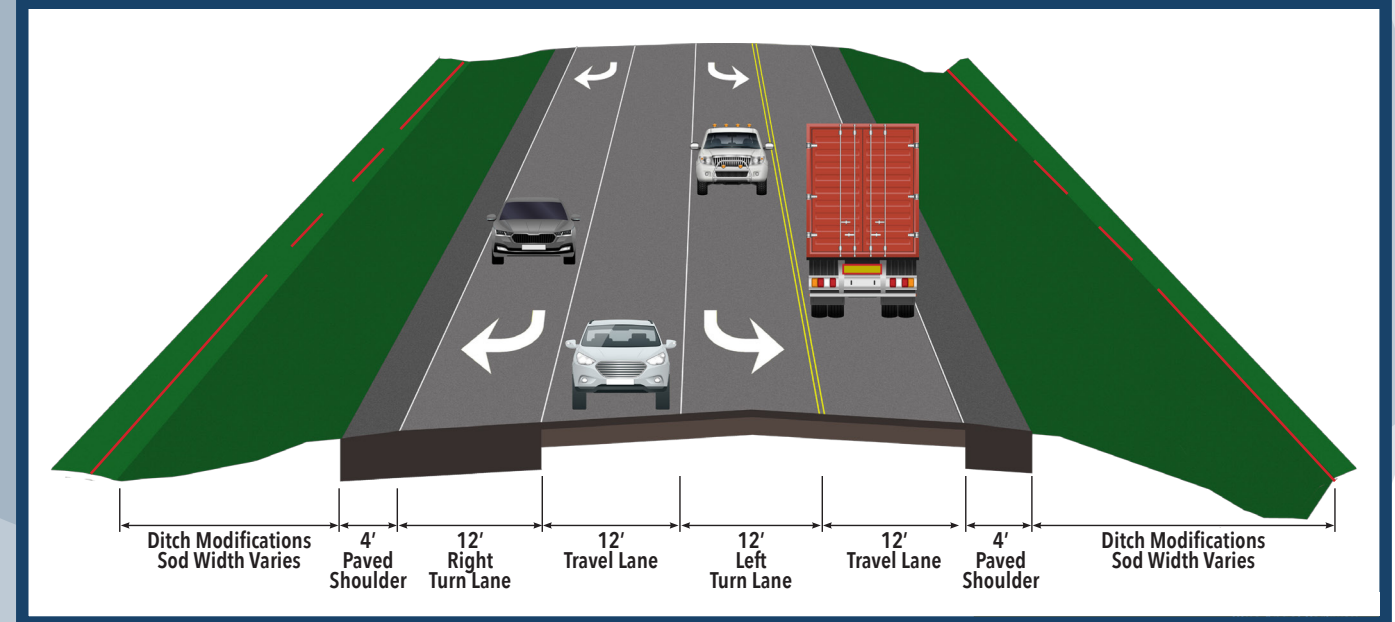
Existing Fairfield Drive

 East of Blue Angel Parkway to west of Fairfield Drive



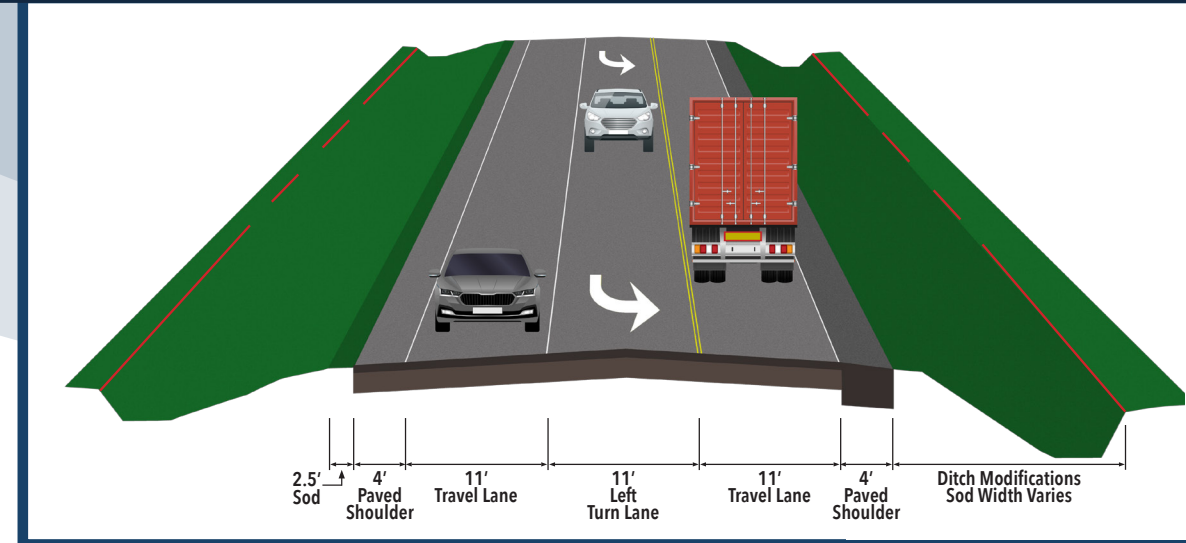
- Proposed features include:
- 11-foot travel lanes
 - Four-foot paved shoulders

- Proposed features include:
- 12-foot travel lanes
 - 12-foot left turn lanes in each direction at the intersection
 - 12-foot right turn lane extension southbound

West of Blue Angel Parkway to east of Blue Angel Parkway
 West of Fairfield Drive to End Project



- Proposed features include:
- 11-foot travel lanes
 - 11-foot left turn lane
 - Four-foot paved shoulders

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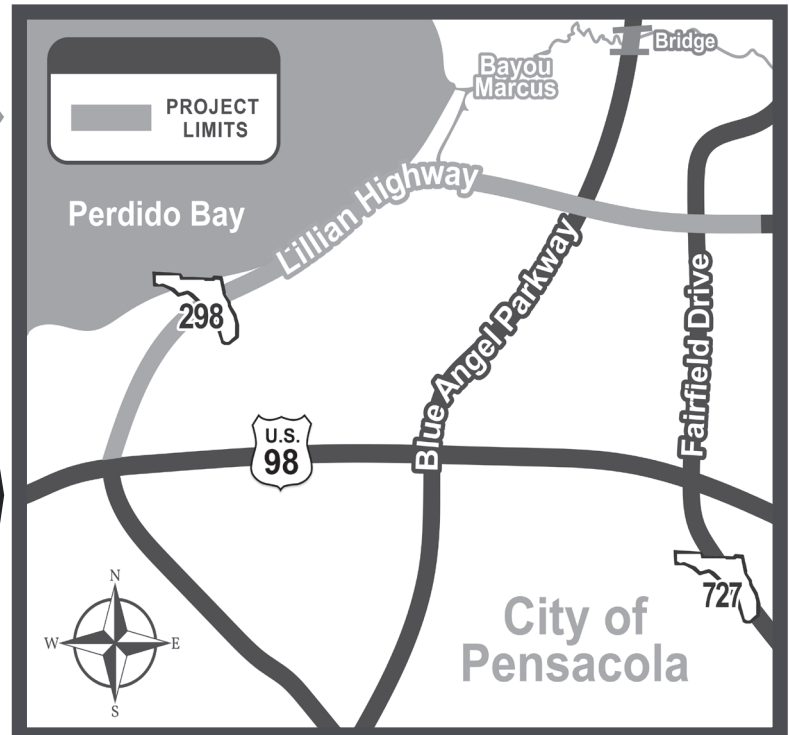
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
