



Project Information

The intent of this project is to provide intersection improvements on U.S. 331 at the I-10 Interchange, Winn Dixie entrance, and U.S. 90.

Intersection 1: Adding traffic signals at I-10 ramps.

Intersection 2: Replacing the traffic signal at Winn Dixie Driveway to improve signal timing and adding a crosswalk across U.S. 331.

Intersection 3: Reconstructing U.S. 331 at U.S. 90 intersection to include:

- Adding a second westbound left-turn lane on U.S. 90
- Adding bicycle accommodations within intersection and adding a crosswalk
- Extending existing left-turn lanes on U.S. 331

The addition of these turn lanes on U.S. 90 will require closing the median opening at 12th Street.







