



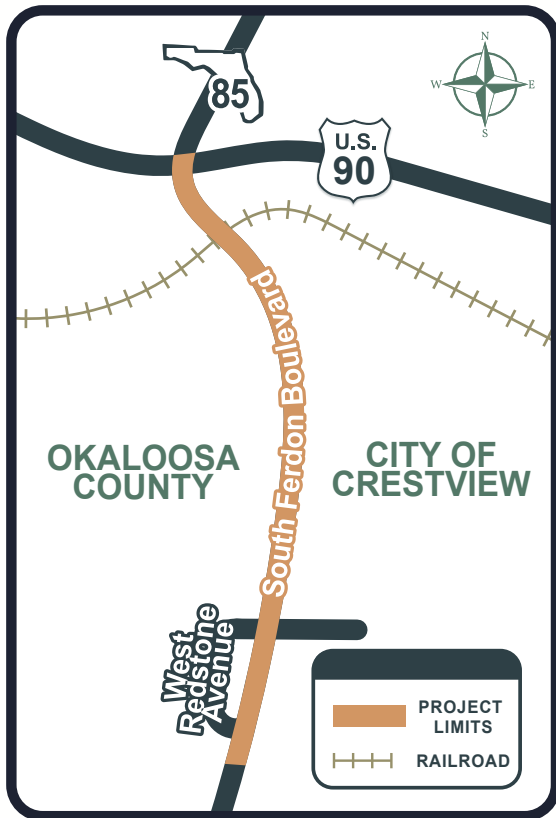
Resurfacing Improvements South Ferdon Boulevard

Project Information

The intent of this project is to resurface all travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, median crossovers, and paved shoulders. No additional right-of-way is needed.

Additional Improvements Include

- Improving sidewalks and pedestrian features to meet current Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards
- Upgrading guardrails and minor drainage improvements

Traffic Impacts

- Lane closures will be allowed 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Friday
- Speed limits will remain the same during construction
- Traffic control officers will be on site during construction at signalized intersections
- Pedestrian traffic will be diverted during sidewalk closures between signalized intersections.

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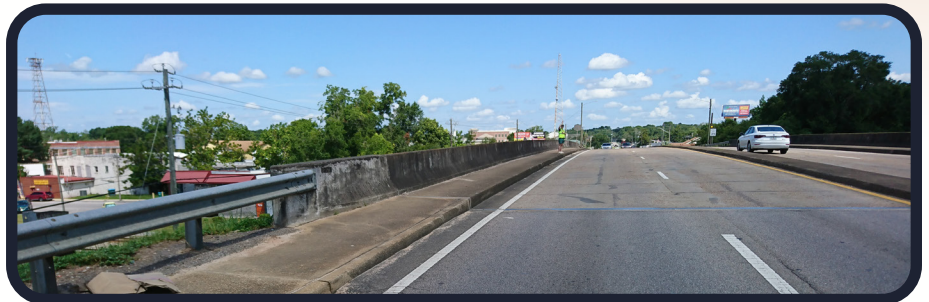

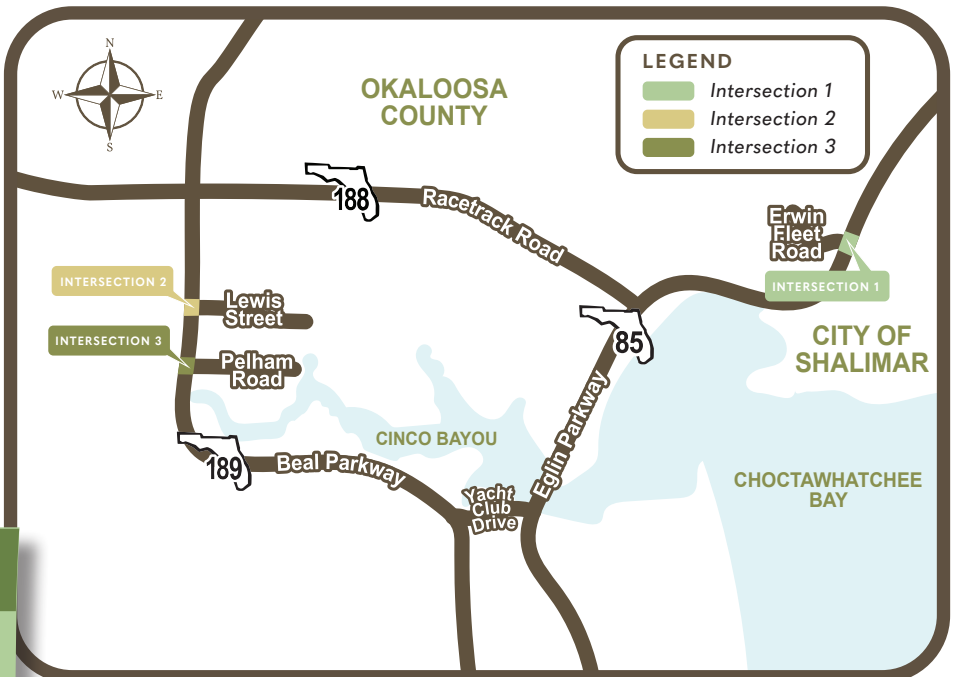


Intersection Improvements

State Road (S.R.) 85 (Eglin Parkway) at Erwin Fleet Road and S.R. 189 (Beal Parkway) at Lewis Street and Pelham Road, Okaloosa County

The intent of this project is to provide improvements to three intersections on Eglin and Beal Parkways at Erwin Fleet Road, Lewis Street, and Pelham Road.

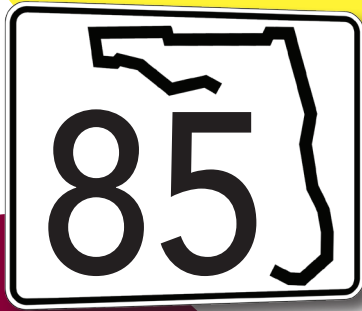

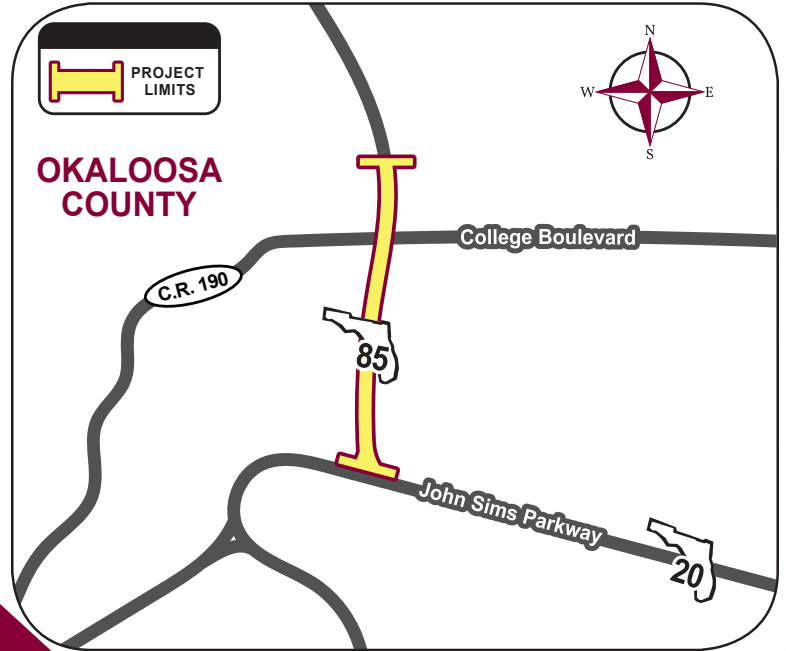

The intent of this project is to resurface existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, median crossovers, and paved shoulders.

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Upgrading signalized intersections and lighting at S.R. 20 (John Sims Parkway) and C.R. 190 (College Boulevard)
- Constructing new sidewalks along the east side and improving existing sidewalks to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Replacing driveways at various locations for safety and ADA improvements



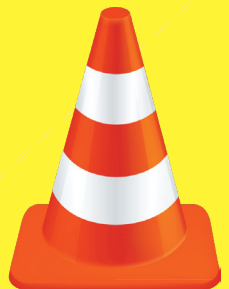

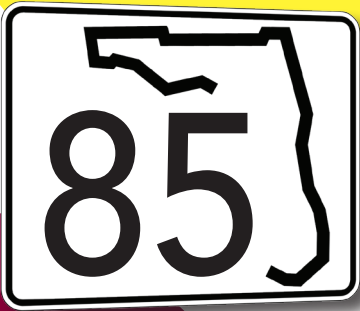

- Lane closures will be allowed Monday through Sunday from 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. to facilitate construction operations.
- Speed limits will remain the same during construction.
