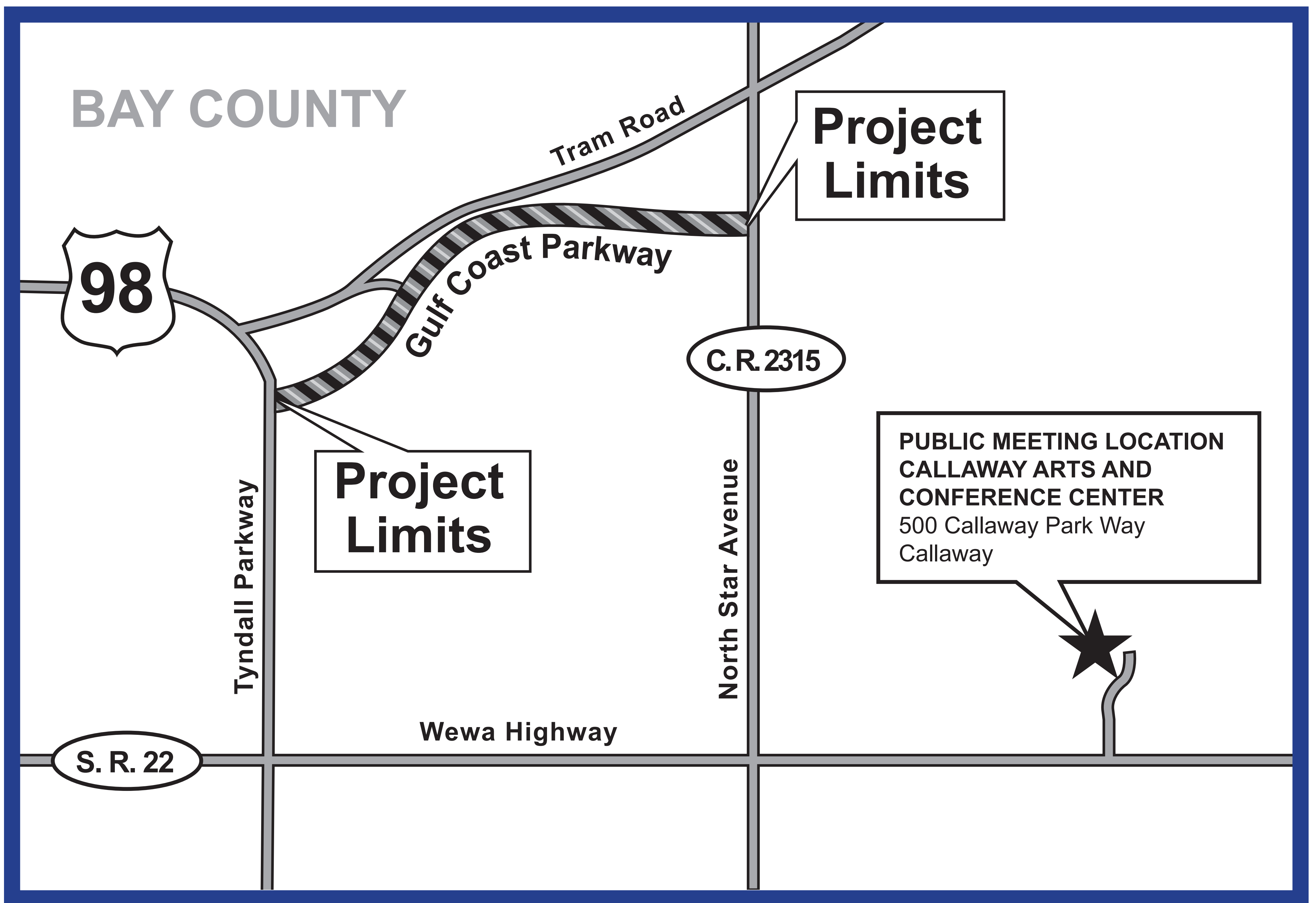


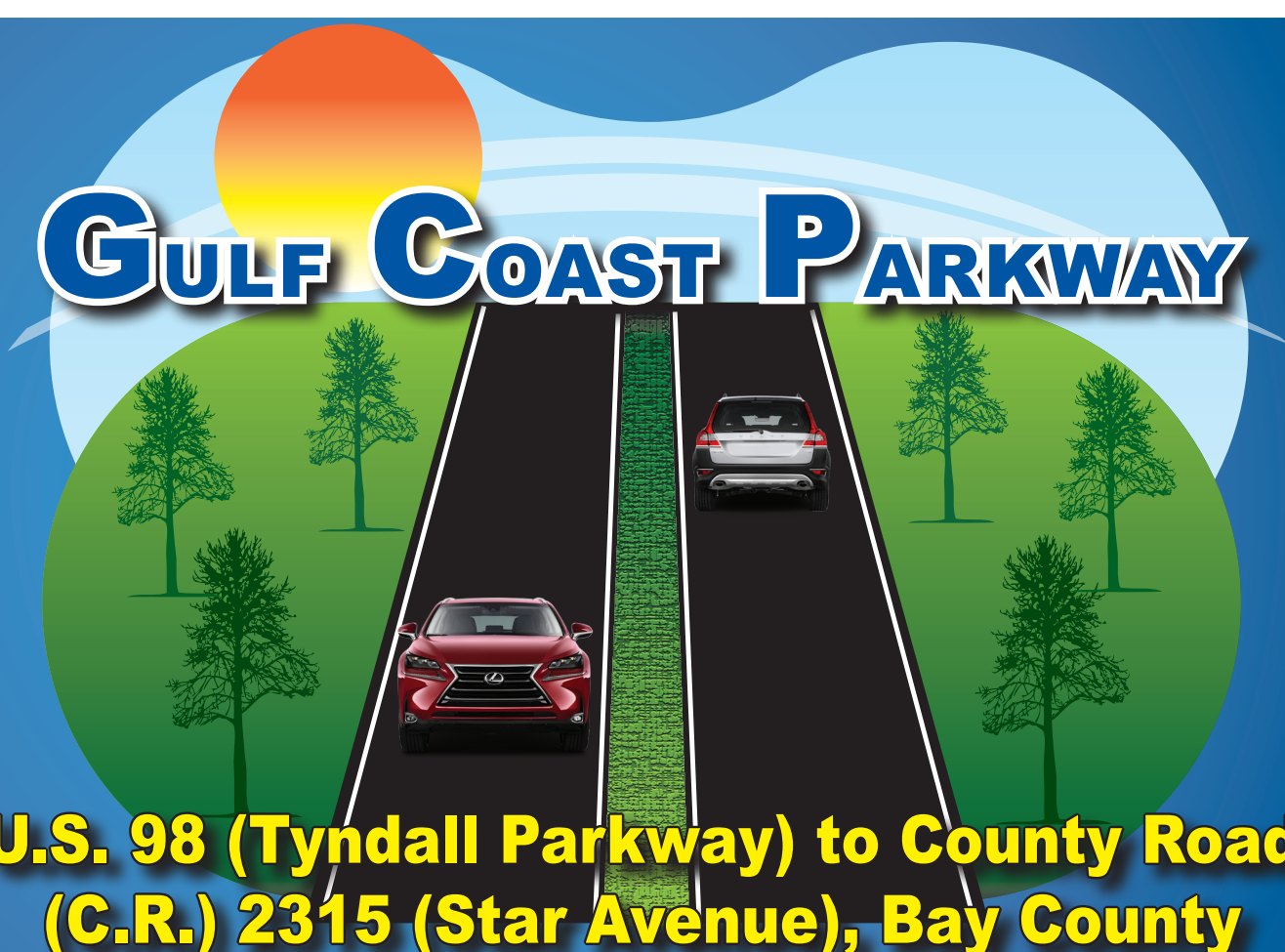

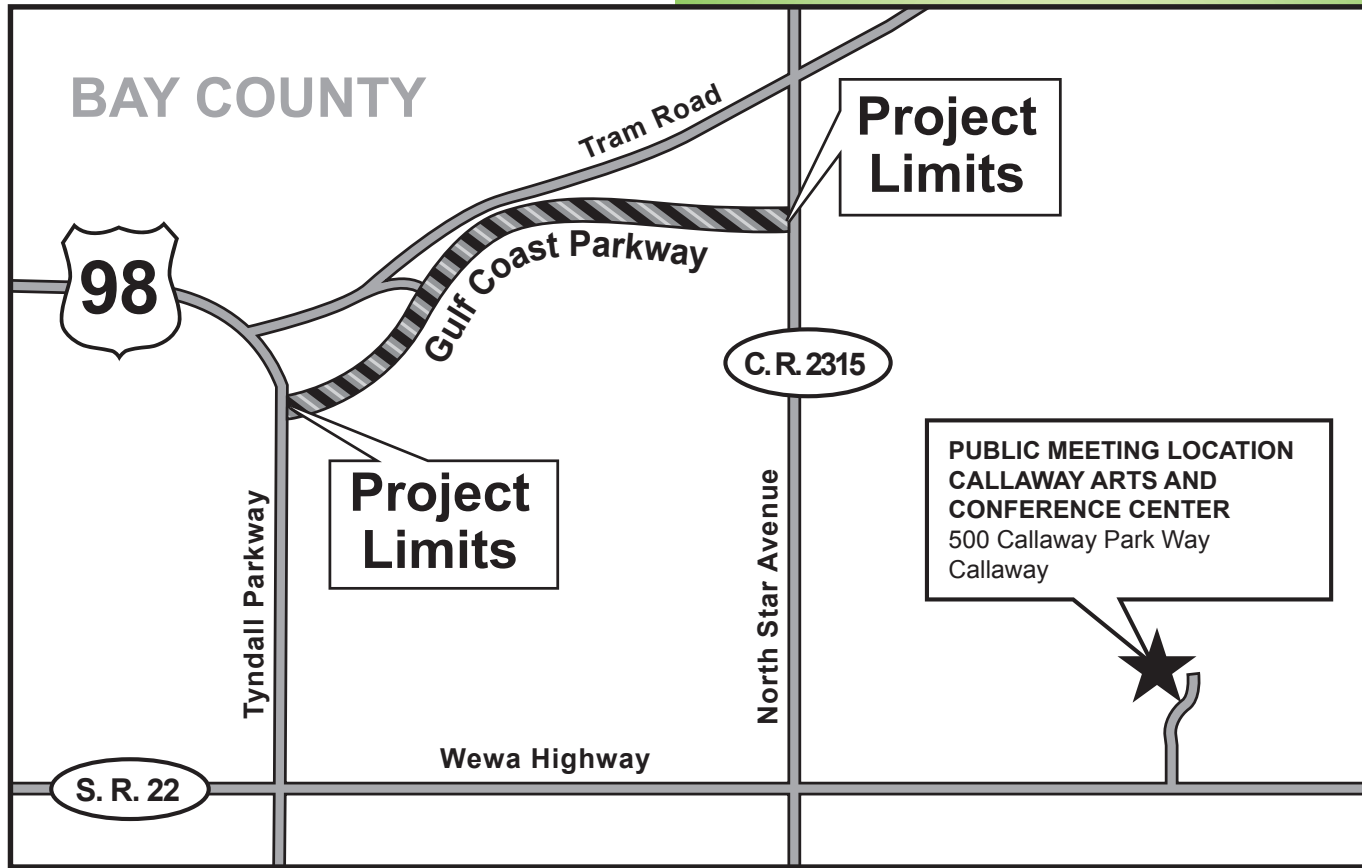

### Historical Information

This Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) design project, known as Segment 8, is an outcome of the Gulf Coast Parkway Project Development and Environment Study (PD&E). The Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E study is planning a new 36-mile state road between Gulf and Bay counties. See the inside map for the proposed alignment and segment 8 location. The proposed alignment was approved by Gulf County in 2015 and Bay County in 2016. The Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E project is scheduled for completion summer 2019.

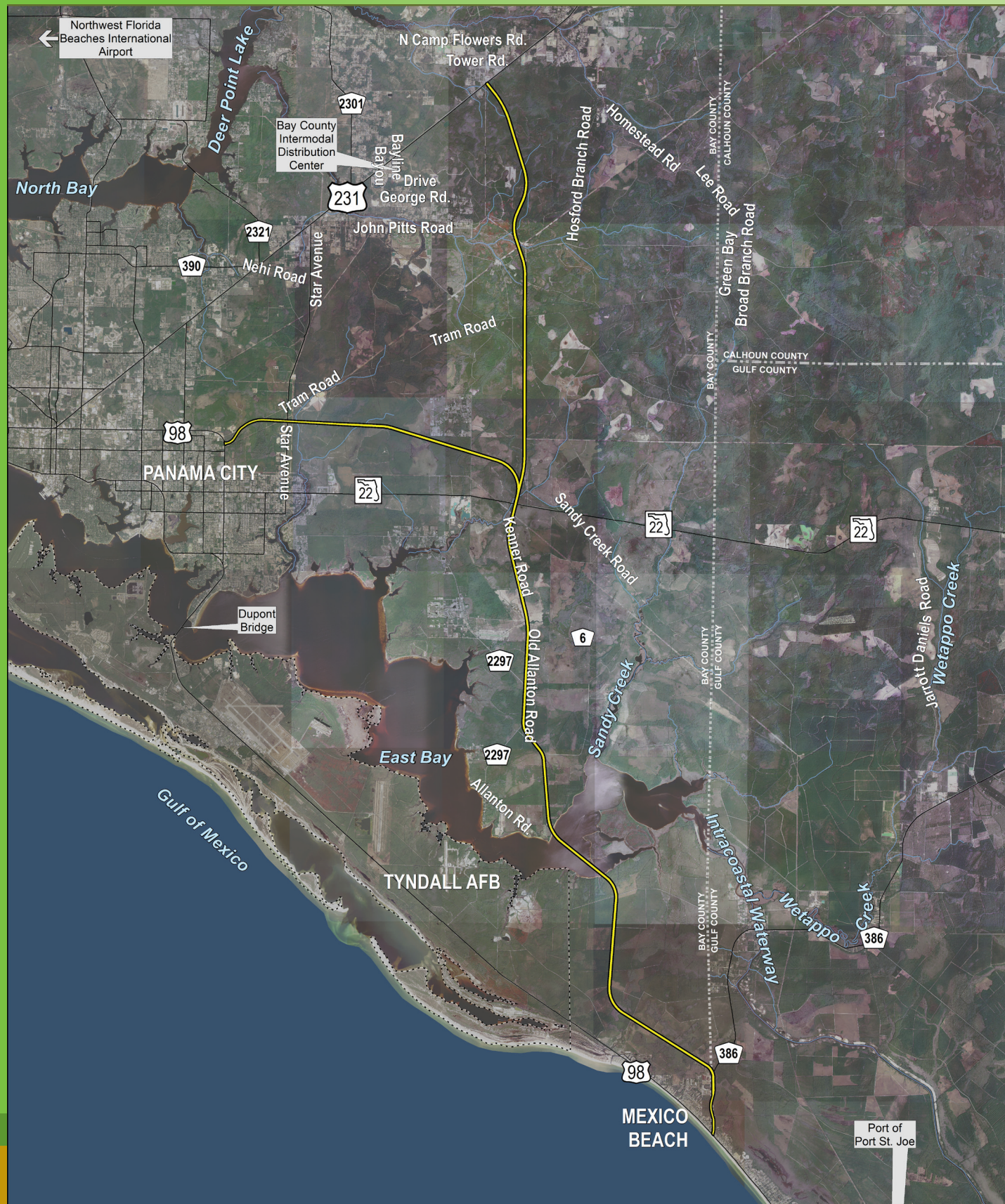

# Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E Preferred Alignment Map

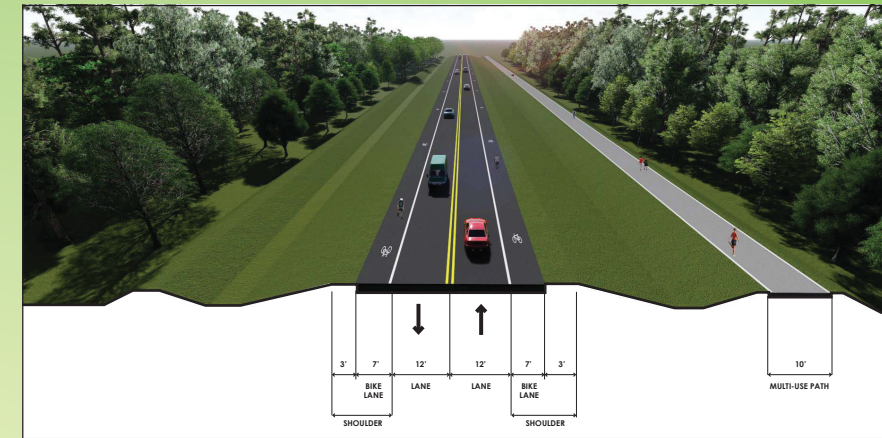

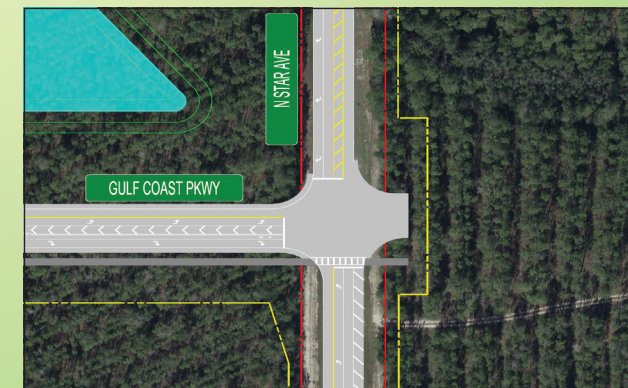


**Gulf Coast Parkway and U.S. 98 (Tyndall Parkway) Proposed Intersection**

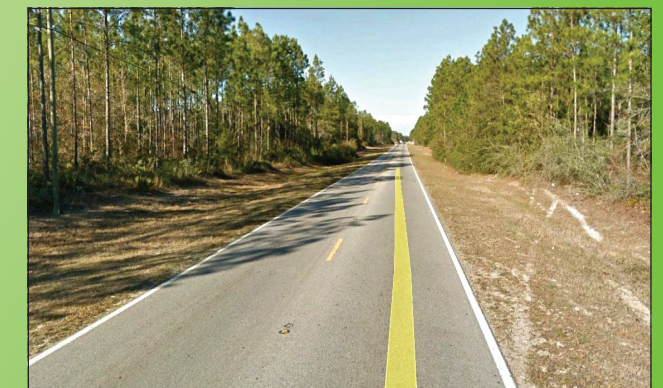


**Existing U.S. 98 (Tyndall Parkway)**

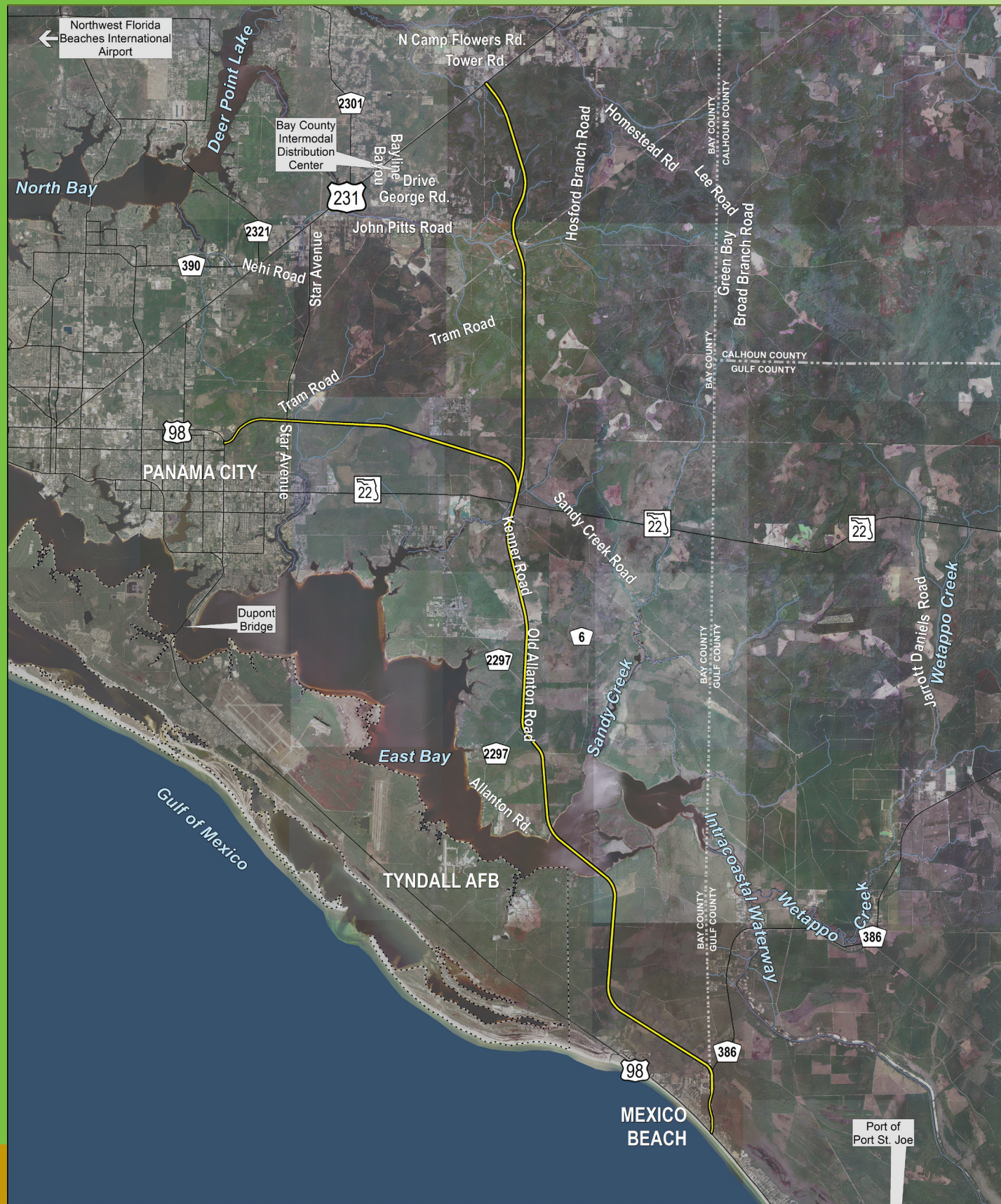

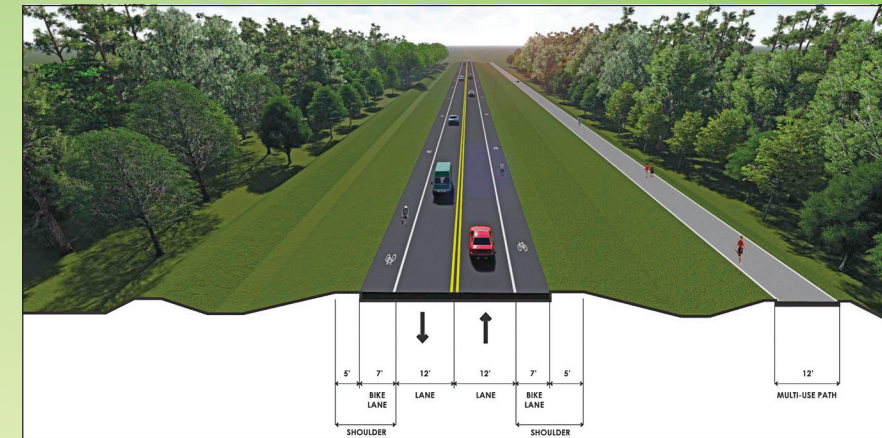

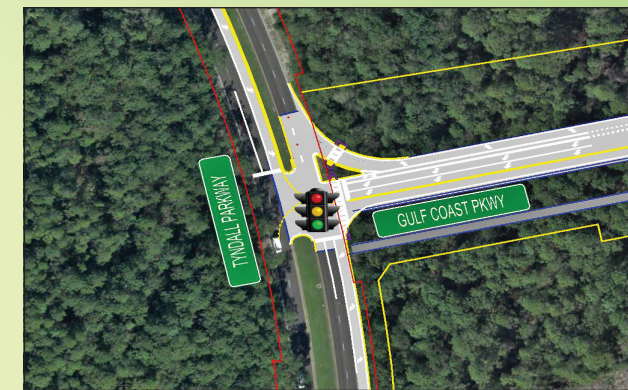
# Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E Preferred Alignment Map

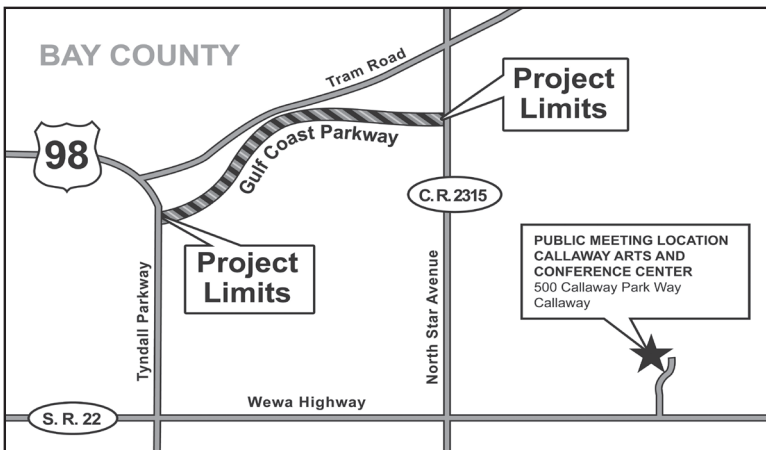
