



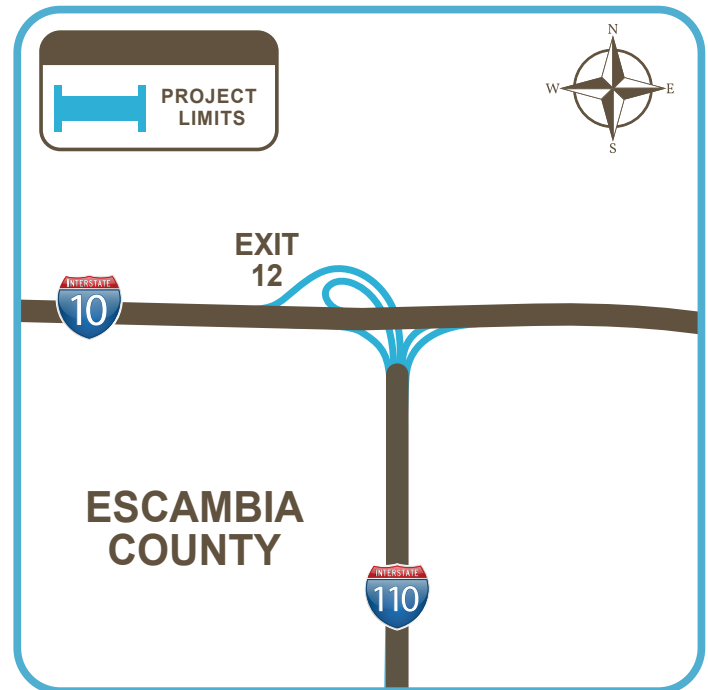
I-10 at I-110 INTERCHANGE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS



Project Information:

Escambia County

The intent of this safety improvement project is to install cautionary speed limit signs, new audible edge lines (see picture below), and barrier reflectors along portions of the I-10 at I-110 interchange ramps. Additional guardrail will be installed along the northbound I-110 to the westbound I-10 ramp. A portion of the interchange ramps will be resurfaced with a final layer containing material to increase friction between the vehicles and the asphalt, providing a clean surface while improving motorist safety.

Safety Improvements Include:

- ▶ Mill and resurface interchange with a final layer to increase friction
- ▶ Install guardrail along northbound I-110 to westbound I-10 ramp
- ▶ Install reflective signs on interchange guardrails and barrier walls along outside of curves
